

- Three day, invitation-only event attended by premier melanoma researchers worldwide
- 300+ global leaders in melanoma; over 60% are academic researchers
- 20+ presentations from world-leading melanoma researchers sharing largely unpublished data
- Small group, topic-focused networking opportunities
- Poster presentations from MRA-funded investigators, including opportunities for live Q&A
- Topics include cutting-edge research results in prevention, detection, and treatment development
- Special Industry Roundtable on key issues impacting melanoma drug development
